JEFFERSON'S TABLE 2.0 BY USABLE TECH CO



WHY INCLUSIVE INNOVATION?

Inclusive Innovation By The Numbers

The Information Technology and Innovation Foundation (ITIF) finds that only 12% of

(ITIF) finds that only 12% of "U.S. innovators" are women, while only 8% are members of minority groups (including Asians, African Americans, Hispanics, Native Americans, and other ethnicities).

At the **National Institute of Health (NIH)** during FY2014,
3% of the applications to the
SBIR programs were from
minority-owned business;
13% of the applications were
from woman-owned
businesses.

From FY2000 to FY2012 Only 7.2% of SBIR/STTR Phase I recipients were members of Minority Owned Small Businesses

From FY2000 to FY2012, Only 10% of SBIR/STTR Phase I recipients were Woman-Owned Small Businesses Less than 1% of all technology start-ups are led by African American or Latino individuals. Minority-owned businesses were 34.7 percent less likely to receive investment from the \$48 billion VC industry.
